

GAC Pool Rules for Swim Meets

1. The main entrance is off limits to the meet. Everyone associated with the meet should enter through the Box Office doors next to the blue awning.

2. Safe Sport:

- a. Only swimmers are allowed in the locker rooms. No coaches or spectators should enter.
- b. Spectators are not allowed on the deck at any time. Only swimmers, volunteers, officials, and coaches may enter the deck.
- c. Spectators are not allowed in the training pool at any time.
- d. Athletes may not enter meeting rooms. This includes Classroom 2 and Hospitality.
- 3. The recreation/therapy pool is off limits to everyone from the meet. No one from the meet (including officials, coaches, swimmers, volunteers, and board members) should go through the glass doors at the scoreboard end of the pool or through the lobby.
- The mezzanine (room above the recreation pool) is off limits to spectators and athletes.
 This area should only be accessed by spectators that utilize the elevator and or need wheelchair access.
- 5. No chairs are allowed in the facility (bleacher seats/cushions are allowed). Chairs should be left in the Special Events Center or in car. If a spectator or coach needs a chair because they cannot sit on bleachers, please alert GAC staff a chair can be provided.
- 6. No coolers of any kind are allowed in the facility.
- 7. No outside food or drink is allowed in the pool facility. The exception is morning coffee. All food and drink can be brought into the tent area inside the Special Events Center. Concessions will be open throughout competition.
- 8. No noisemakers of any kind are allowed in the facility.
- 9. No balloons or inflatables of any kind are allowed in the facility.
- 10. Under no circumstance should any swimmer attempt to swim under any bulkhead. Doing so will result in expulsion from the facility and closure of the pool.
